



## 2021 Scholarship Application Packet

### **Scholarship Facts:**

#### **1. How Much are the Scholarships for?**

The scholarships are for \$700.00 each. We do reserve the right to increase the amount awarded or the number of scholarships awarded each year depending on the success of our fundraising. For 2021 we are planning to award at least three scholarships.

#### **2. For Which Institutions can the scholarship be used?**

All post high school level work at any institution. This includes any college or university at any level (bachelors, masters, or doctorate). It also includes trade school, technical school, or professional school. The student may attend on a full-time, part-time, or correspondence basis.

#### **3. Who is eligible?**

- Any registered member of St. Paul's and their immediate family members. The immediate family of the registered member includes his or her spouse, children, brothers, sisters, parents, grandparents, grandchildren, aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and great-grandchildren.
- The applicant must be living in the registered member's home or be substantially dependent on the registered member (e.g., dorm student).
- Applicants must be at least 16 years old.
- Individuals who have won *two* Knights of Columbus scholarships in previous years are ineligible.

#### **4. What is the Schedule for applying for and awarding this scholarship?**

Applications will be made available to the parish on April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Deadline for submission is Sunday, May 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Scholarships to be awarded (tentatively) at the graduate Mass in June 2021. Completed applications *should be submitted electronically* to Sean McGee at [seanmcgeek@gmail.com](mailto:seanmcgeek@gmail.com) before the deadline date. *Please be sure to change the name of your saved PDF form by appending your name to the filename using the "Save As" function of your PDF editor. Be sure to do this first before editing the PDF.*

#### **5. What is the Selection Process?**

A panel of 5 KC members will be formed. The members of the panel are the Grand Knight, one of the trustees, and three members-at-large from the general membership. The panel will review all applications and determine the most deserving individuals. If the winners cannot be selected by the review process, the panel will conduct a personal interview with a selected list of applicants. The panel is not required to interview all applicants; only those few considered to be deserving based on the evaluation of the applications. A panel member will be replaced if one of his immediate family (see definition above) applies for this scholarship. Decision of the review panel will be final.

#### **6. Who will be awarded the scholarship?**

Based on the evaluation and, if needed, the interview process, the top individuals will be awarded the scholarships. No distinction will be made for gender. This means that the scholarships could be awarded to any combination of male and female applicants.
